**The Sixth Annual Glendale Open Studio Tour
Saturday, July 24, 2010 12pm - 6pm**

Artists and arts organizations are invited to participate in the **Sixth Annual Open Studio Tour (OST)** by opening their studios and facilities to the public for free throughout the day. This event will bring attention to and promote the many artists, young and distinguished, living and working in Glendale. It will also draw attention to the interesting and diverse art organizations and galleries located throughout the City and give artists the opportunity to sell their artwork directly to the public.

At the 2008 Open Studio Tour we had over 148 artists and art groups exhibiting their artwork from 45 locations and 1500 people from the public attended the tour. Artists from Burbank, Los Angeles, Pasadena and other cities also joined the Tour to aid the City of Glendale in establishing a solid foundation as an artistic colony.

This year again, flyers, postcards and maps, as well as a preview of the exhibiting artists' work and contact information, will be available on the City's Arts and Culture website: www.GlendaleArtsandCulture.org. The OST organizers will promote the event and produce a map that will list names, addresses and genres of the artwork being displayed at each location. The map will be distributed through the Internet and in select public places. OST flags will be placed outside each studio and art facility to identify participating locations. Advertising opportunities will be offered to artists and art organizations as well as to businesses for a small fee. Details about this year's Beeline route will be announced at a later date.

Every participating artist can exhibit one artwork at the **Brand Library Art Galleries** from July 17 to August 13 and will be displayed on the City of Glendale's Arts and Culture website.

The Opening Reception is on **Sunday, July 18 from 3 – 5pm.**

HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

There is no charge for artists and arts organizations to participate, but a completed and signed application as well as a CD with no more than (2) two digital images* of your work for the website should be submitted no later than **Friday, May 28 at 5:00pm.**

Downloadable applications with important dates and guidelines are available online as well.

ONLY ARTISTS WHO PARTICIPATE IN THE OPEN STUDIO TOUR ARE ELIGIBLE TO SHOW IN THE BRAND LIBRARY ART GALLERY EXHIBITION. One (1) artwork will be accepted per participant. Please ensure that the artwork has not been exhibited at the Brand Library Art Gallery previously and is framed professionally and prepared for hanging. Any 3-dimensional works must fit on pedestals with the longest side of 20", or as supplied by the artist. Works for the exhibition must be delivered directly to the gallery on the date specified below. Brand Library Art Gallery is located at 1601 West Mountain between Grandview and Western. Please use the back door library delivery entrance to drop off artwork. Artwork must be picked up at the conclusion of the exhibition from the gallery on **Saturday, August 14 between 9am - 12pm.**
